
What can you do to help?

Grace and Peace A message from Pastor Bryan

Sunday, April 2 marks the closing of Lent and the beginning of Holy Week. It is the week before Easter when we remember and observe the final events leading up to Jesus' death and resurrection. We do some things on this week that we do not do other weeks of the year.

As a church we will gather for worship on Palm Sunday and celebrate Jesus' triumphant entrance into Jerusalem, waving palm branches and cheering on



our king, our messiah. On Maundy Thursday we will gather to honor and partake in the institution of the Lord's Supper, the first Passover meal in which Christ's own body and blood are offered as part of the meal, and also to remember the night our Lord Jesus was betrayed. At the end of the service the altar, lectern and pulpit are stripped and left bare until Easter to symbolize "the humiliation and barrenness of the cross."

On Good Friday we gather for one of the most moving worship experiences of the year, to hear and to reflect upon Jesus' extreme act of love for us in giving up his life as a sacrifice for our sins upon the cross.

Finally, on Easter Sunday, we celebrate our risen King, who conquered death and the grave, rising alive from the tomb, and granting all who believe everlasting life with him in his kingdom when our own life and our work on earth has been completed. At Easter, the color white symbolizes purity, grace, and, ultimately, the resurrection of Jesus Christ, which is the joyful culmination of this most holy Week.


Holy week for Christians is the most significant week of the year and thus is called holy. Holy means to be different and to be set apart. I like this idea that holy week is not every week. It is one week of the year and then we move on. It is a week where we are reminded of Jesus' suffering and of the reality of our sin. The sorrow of Holy Week is brought to an abrupt end with the joy of Easter Sunday. Like the psalmist proclaims in Psalm 30:5 "weeping may go on all night, but joy comes with the morning."

Maybe that's just the point. We are not to continue to dwell upon our sin and our suffering. Easter morning comes where Christ stands triumphant. Yes, we take the time to reflect upon our sin and our sorrow. There is a time for that. But God has not called us to live in sin and sorrow. Jesus died to take away our sin that we might live in Easter victory. Sure, it helps to remember where we came from, but like the Israelites, we're not going back to Egypt.

So please join me in observing this one week of the year as Holy Week, but even more so, join me in celebrating and living in the triumphant victory of Jesus each and every day. There is no challenge that is too great that you face in your life that God cannot overcome. Jesus' victory over the grave shows us that is true! You were created to overcome all things through Jesus Christ who loves us, protects us, defends us, and shows us grace and mercy beyond the cross and the open tomb. His love endures forever.




Egg Hunt 11:15am


